

Subdivision Naming Guidelines

Naming a road in a subdivision

Macedon Ranges Shire Council is responsible for the naming of roads, streets, and places within the shire under the *Local Government Act 1989*. However, subdivisions that propose new roads typically have names supplied by developers and land surveyors.

The information below aims to strengthen and enhance naming applications to reflect names that are relevant to our history and heritage, that are enduring and reflective of community values.

Council's process is guided by the <u>Naming Rules for places in Victoria</u> and operates a naming working group that can provide further assistance. As the responsible naming authority, Council must approve proposed names prior to the Certification of the Plan of Subdivision as they are required to be shown on this plan.
