

Create a possum nest

Did you know Common Brushtail Possums prefer to live in tree hollows, whereas the Ringtail Possum will create a nest high up in a tree? Here is a step-by-step guide to create a possum nest ready for Ringtails to move in.

Materials

- Hanging baskets x2 (approx. 30cm diameter)
- · Cable ties or wire
- Wire cutters
- Gloves (for handling materials)

Make your nest

- 1. Remove the chain from the hanging baskets.
- Put one basket on top of the other and secure them together with cable ties around the circumference to provide stability for the nest.
- 3. Use wire cutters to cut out an entry.
- 4. Using scissors, cut the coconut fibre to create an opening and fold it back over the wire and secure it with cable ties.
- Reconnect one of the chains that you removed earlier. Make sure the basket hangs evenly.
- Attach the nest securely to a branch using strong rope or cable ties, ensuring it doesn't swing excessively in the wind.
 Hang in a safe location at least 3 meters high in a tree, away from predators like cats and foxes.

Tips

- Possums will bring in their own bedding materials.
- Position the entrance towards a tree trunk for easy access.
- Monitor the nest from a distance to ensure it is being used by possums.
- Avoid handling the nest after installation to minimise stress on wildlife.
- Nearby native trees and shrubs will provide food sources.
