PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

I, _____, Parent/Guardian (must be over 18) of _____ agree to them taking part in this Youth Development Unit program and:

- Artists will follow the instructions of Council and Security staff
- Artists will be at the event at the time to them provided Council
- The event is strictly drug, alcohol, vape, and smoke free with no pass outs. All artists and their support crews will adhere to the guidelines for the event.
- Artists may be required to undertake a bag/vehicle inspection by security staff prior to entering the event
- Artists and crew are expected to wear a pass at all times during the event. Passes will be available for collection at the event
- Artists will be responsible for their equipment while at the event (a secure place will be provided by Council when the artist is not using their equipment).
- A backstage area will be provided. This area is for artists and crew only. People who are not artists or crew found backstage will be asked to leave the venue
- Artists will not cause damage to the venue or equipment provided at the venue
- No fire, smoke machines, use of dangerous weapons or emissions of bodily fluids will be permitted. Artists will not be permitted to throw objects into the audience/crowd or from the stage
- Swearing or abusive language will not be permitted at any time during the event. The event is discrimination free, and artists making comments that are discriminatory (racial, homophobic, prejudice, etc.) will be asked to leave the stage immediately and will be disqualified from the competition
- Artists will not abuse people within the crowd, incite misbehaviour of any kind and will not encourage potentially dangerous or anti-social behaviour. If the audience is deemed to be unsafe artists will be asked to stop playing until the situation is safe
- People from the audience will not be permitted on stage at any time
- Artists will adhere strictly to the set times. Points will be deducted from artists who take longer than the agreed upon time
- All judging decisions are final and no correspondences regarding results will be entered into on the night or thereafter
- Judges will consider original music more favourably than cover material
- Artists agree to use a provided backline (drums, amps, etc) where reasonable. Extra time taken to set up and pack down equipment will result in shorter performance times.
- I Acknowledge the program undertakes a number of activities which may have inherent risks where injury may occur. I understand Macedon Ranges Shire Council and its representatives are acting in good faith to provide a reasonably safe environment for participants to undertake these activities
- I Agree Macedon Ranges Shire Council are not responsible for the loss or theft of their personal property and/or valuables when involved in the program
- I Agree they will report to the leader or the program supervisor any accident, injury or near miss which may have occurred when participating in the program
- I Authorise staff, in the event of an accident or illness, to obtain all necessary medical assistance and treatment for the participant, including transport by ambulance if required

- In the event of the participant requiring medical attention. I understand that the program workers will endeavour to communicate with me concerning the required action
- I acknowledge that photos/videos/audio recordings may be taken during the program, and I consent that I/my child may be included in these photos/videos, which may be used by the council in various forms of media
- The bands and artists performing at the event will actively promote the event on any social media platforms they have, and may be asked to provide evidence of their promotion to Council
