- Double unit with learning areas arranged to provide activities that engage children's interests and provide opportunities for both individual and group learning.
- Large, newly renovated outdoor area incorporating natural play spaces.
- Space for group games as well as quiet areas for small groups.
- Large mature trees providing shade during warm months.
- Two playgrounds joined by a shared bike path.
- Children share both playgrounds, having opportunities to develop friendships with children in different groups.
- Veggie garden, fruit trees, worm farm and composting.
- Stage area for performances.
- Cubby houses and challenging climbing equipment.
